School Development Plan Update

You may remember at the start of the academic year that we announced our school development priorities as:

- Adopting a 'Talk for Writing' approach to teaching Literacy to raise standards in writing
- Enhancing the quality of learning under the mastery curriculum
- Promoting positive learning behaviours (being independent, being ambitious, being resilient, working together, supporting others and keeping focus)

Teachers and Teaching Assistants were trained in Talk for Writing in September and we have been experimenting with and developing our understanding of the approach since. Anecdotally, we feel that there has been a big impact on the standard of writing and we will be measuring the impact across the year.

We have devoted a number of staff meetings to the quality of learning and our new Teaching and Learning Policy is available on our website.

We are pleased with the impact of our emphasis on Learning Powers in developing positive learning behaviours. I was in classes yesterday and heard children and teachers talking about being ambitious. Having high expectations and a belief that children 'can' is so important for all of us - staff, parents and carers and the children themselves.


